Your Benefits as a Supporter

Your **contribution** helps us finance the training of mountain rescuers. You help us take preventive measures and carry out rescue operations.

The membership fee includes:

Annual report

Every year, our supporters receive a copy of the Annual Report, informing them about what has been done at the local centres over the past year and about the mountain rescuer training activities. The Annual Report additionally contains some vital information on "rules of safe behaviour in Alpine territory".

Information exchange between mountain rescue teams

As a Supporter, you can always draw on the resources and expertise of the mountain rescue teams. Active members will always be happy to help you by providing advice and active assistance.

Price reductions at mountain rescue service events

As a Supporter, you benefit from various price reductions at mountain rescue service events (entry fees for sports events, other entrance fees, etc.)

Coverage of costs of search and rescue (insurance)

Since our rescue equipment and training schemes all need to be financed, it is impossible for rescue operations in Alpine territory to be free of charge – even though, nationwide, more than 11,000 people do voluntary work for the mountain rescue services. The hours we spend on rescue operations in the mountains because of leisure-time accidents have to be charged. With a minimum support contribution of **22.– euros*** a year the mountain rescue insurance will cover your rescue costs in a case of emergency up to a maximum amount of 15,000.– euros. The insurance covers your immediate family and/or partner living in the same household and children up to the age of 18. The insurance coverage is valid all over the world (incl. ground and air rescue operations in case of emergency in the mountains and on the water) and starts one day after you pay the support contribution. It includes assistance after accidents on skiing slopes and aviation sports (no return costs).

Search operations and tragedies are avoidable

Up in the mountains bad things can happen more quickly than you think. Before setting out on a tour, please always tell your relatives, friends and accommodation providers where you are going and when you are planning to return. Depending on the season, always take the recommended equipment with you: mobile phone, protective clothing, wind and weather-resistant, bivouac bag, headlamp, signal whistle, food and drink, avalanche beacon, avalanche probe and avalanche shovel per person taking part in a skiing, snowboard or snowshoe tour. Practise! Take courses. And please read the related literature! Managing risk is of utmost importance, especially for amateurs.

* This contribution includes an insurance premium which is forwarded, without deduction, to the insurance company. The remaining amount is your membership fee.

In the event of damage or loss, please send us the bill for search and rescue expenses and a copy of the pay-in slip to confirm the bank transfer, and please include a brief description of the accident. Send it by mail to the regional organisation in the federal province where you are registered as a Supporter.
